CONTEST RULES

1. HOW TO ENTER & ELIGIBILITY

No Purchase Necessary. Contest is open to residents British Columbia only. Entrants can enter to win services from CityWest.

Contest runs Friday, June 2, 2023, from 12-3 p.m.

To be eligible, participant must fill out a entry form online or ballot form between 12 and 3 p.m. Further, you must be a Canadian resident 18 years of age or older. Void where prohibited. Contest is not open to employees of CityWest, its affiliated companies or subsidiaries, its sales agents, its advertising and promotional agencies, and members with whom they are domiciled.

2. THE PRIZE
